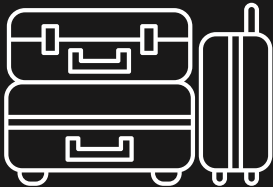
This guide will give you **insider tips** to help you travel smarter, so you can enjoy every trip without the headaches. Let's dive in!



PACK LIKE A PRO

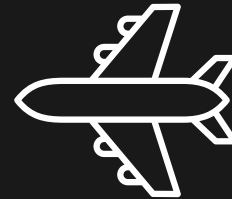

SAVE ON FLIGHTS + HOTELS

The best deals are typically **6-8 weeks in advance** for international and 3-4 weeks for domestic travel

When searching for flights, **use private browsing** or incognito mode to avoid price increases



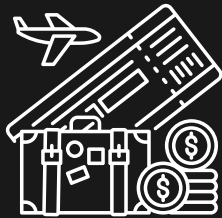
Sign up for **price alerts**. Apps like **Google Flights**, **Skyscanner** and **Hopper** track prices for you

Flexible on departure? **Use the 'flexible on date' search feature** on Skyscanner to find the cheapest month and day to fly

STAY SAFE

If it sounds **too good to be true**, it probably is. Walk away!

Research **common scams** and tourist traps before you go.



Use an **RFID-blocking wallet** to avoid digital theft.

Avoid **flashy displays** and be mindful of pickpockets



I travel with a **simple canvas tote bag** held close to me in crowds. It never draws attention



I use a **phone sling** or lanyard to keep my **phone secured to my wrist or bag**

Airalo - Get connected with an eSIM

Klook - Book tours, airport transfers and tickets to attractions.
Use code TRAVELFORPHOEBEKLOOK for a discount.

Grab, Uber, Bolt and DiDi - Safer than hailing a taxi

Skyscanner for flights and **Agoda** for hotels

XE Currency - Avoid getting ripped off on exchange rates

TripIt - Organise all your reservations in one place

Google Maps - Download maps offline and star places

Google Translate - Use the camera feature to translate menus,
signs and more instantly

Things **will go wrong**. Stay calm and go with the flow - **everything always works out**.

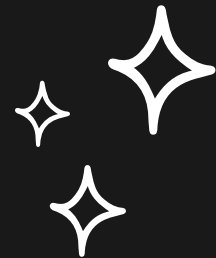
You'll be amazed how **a simple smile and a friendly, 'Hello,'** connects you with locals.
